Subs for 2016 agreed as £35 from 1<sup>st</sup> March 2016, £20 from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2017 for new folks joining after that date. Early bird discount of £5. See Phil.

**London Marathon club places criteria** agreed as: 10 Points must be achieved from any of the following categories:-1 point per marshalling at A20, Worthington or Adrian Smith

1 point per committee post held on either IR or A20 1 point for leading to completion an IR 10 week beginners course

1 Point for making a significant contribution to the club to be agreed by the committee

1 point for each league race competed in from  $01^{st}$  Jan to  $1^{st}$  Oct.

Points must come from a mix of volunteering (i.e. the first four categories) and racing; the 5 year exclusion clause will also remain.

Note that LRRL winter league races are "closed" and no preentry is required. Also, the Club pays your entry fee !! (wooo hoooo).


BDSL and LRRL Summer Races are open and you enter any pay in usual manner.
